Formation: Couples side by side, facing CCW; M inside, W outside;
inside hands joined. Start with outside feet: M-L, W-R.
Steps are described for M.

THE DANCE.

Meas.	Steps
1 - 4	Introduction
	<u>FIGURE I</u>
1 - 2	L, fwd, step-bend
3 - 4	R fwd, step-bend
5 - 8	Rept. 1-4
9 -11	Ptrs face each other; Yem L
12	Hop on L
13	R to R side
14	Cross L in frt of R
15	Hop on L
16	R to R side
17 - 32	Rept. 1 - 16
	<u>FIGURE II</u>
L - 2	Face CCW. Step-hop fwd (M-L, W-R), swinging joined hds fwd;
3- 4	Step-hop fwd (M-R, W-L), swinging joined hds bwd.
5 - 6	Step-hop fwd (M-L, W-R), swinging joined hds fwd. On hop release hds, turn 1/4 turn to L side. (Ptrs now are b to b)
7	Touch R (W-L) toe to floor, bend down & clap.
8	Pause
9 - 12	Reverse 1-4, starting with M-R, w-L, fwd.

Meas.	Steps
13 - 14	Step-hop fwd on R (W-L). On hop make 1/4 turn to R side, ptrs face each other.
15	Touch L (W-R) toe to floor. At the same time M's R hand claps W's L.
16	Pause
17 - 32	Rept. 1 - 16.

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
