

 **KHAN AMIRI** — is a line dance which is a dance of happiness, joy and usually done at weddings and at most joyous occasions - simple to perform. Men's and women's lines are separate which later join together. Leader of lines waves a handkerchief.

| 1-6 | In line of direction beginning on right foot, hop right, hop left, hop right foot to side |
| 7-12 | step left bringing right foot behind left bending body, left foot slightly lifted, land-in on left foot. |
| 13-16 | Kick out left foot, then bring back close to right foot $2/4$ beat. |
