Record: TANZ SP 23-067

Formation: Couples on line of circle, facing in LOD, forward
cross hand hold, right arms on top.

Measures $3/4$ time

- 1-4 twelve running steps forward with an accent on each
1st count of the measure, then make a half turn (toward
each other)
- 5-8 and twelve running steps backward in LOD, half turn
(toward each other)
- 9-12 with six running steps turn CW in place, he moving
forward, she moving backward, the make $1/2$ turn (as
above) and
- 11-12 with six running steps turn CW, he moving backward
and she fwd., then make $1/2$ turn; M must see to it that
W is now on outside of circle.
- 13-14 release left hand hold, W turns twice CW under raised
right hands.
- 15 he turns once CCW under raised right hands
- 16 back to original position. Man stamps twice.
