KOSOVA NEDA GRIVNA

This dance is from the village of Shilova near Gnilane in southeast Kosovo. It was taught by Janet Reineck at the 1985 Kolo Festival. I am calling it 'Kosova' Neda Grivna to distinguish it from the 'ballroom kolo' version of Neda Grivna.

Formation: open circle, 'W' hold Rhythm: 7/8 (S-Q-Q)

No introduction

- MEAS. 1 Step R ft to R (S), step L across R to R (Q-Q)
 - 2 Step R ft to R (S), touch L fwd (Q-Q)
 - 3 Step L fwd (S), touch R fwd (Q-Q)
 - 4 Step R fwd (S), touch L fwd (Q-Q)
 - 5 Step L fwd (S), touch R fwd (Q-Q)
 - 6 Step R back (S), touch L fwd (Q-Q)
 - 7 Step L back (S), Touch R fwd (Q-Q)
 - 8 Step R back (S), touch L fwd (Q-Q)
 - 9 Small step L ft to L (S), step R across L to L (Q-Q)
 - 10 Small step L ft to L (S), touch R ft beside L (Q-Q)

Short cue: 3 steps to R

- 3 step-touches to center
- 3 step-touches back
- 3 small steps to L

Music gradually speeds up. DON'T RUSH IT!
