There are many versions of Kuratsa dances, the steps and figures of which depend upon the ability and mood of the dancers at the time of the performance. This version comes from Culasi, Antique.

COSTUME: The Girl wears patadyong, camisa or kimona, with a soft panuelo, the Boy, camisa de chino or barong tagalog with white or any color of trousers.

MUSIC is composed of two parts: A and B.

COUNT one, two, three to a measure.

FORMATION: Partners face each other about six feet apart. Girl stands at right side of Boy when facing audience.
