## LAENDLER (Laendler from lower Bavaria)

Record: Tanz IP 58107

Formation: Couples on the line of the circle, all facing in LOD, she hooks her L arm into his R, inside hands are joined, he presses her arm toward him with his right elbow.

Meas. 1st figure

- 1-8 slow, lightly swinging walking steps, one step in each 3/4 meas. (dancers usually sing a song to this part)

  2nd figure
- 1-8 repetition release hold, she turns CW constantly, progressing in LOD (called) radeln) while he "stalks" after her (nachst eigen) one step per meas. for him, clapping.
- 3rd figure
  9-16 Two hand hold, arms stretched forward, position slightly askew, so that left shoulders are adjacent, move CCW, he one step in each measure, she three steps to a meas. At meas. 15 release his left and her R hand, he turns CW under his right arm and stamps at meas. 16.

Two hand hold, partners facing, M back to center she turns once CW moving in LOD, swing joined hands over her head

- 18 he turns once CCW moving in LOD, swing joined hands over his head
- 19 as meas. 17
- swing joined hands forward arms a r e c r o s s e d
  21-24 swing arms backward, release hold of his left and her
  right, she turns twice CCW under his raised R hand,
  turns once more CCW into his R arm, which then lies
  on her R shoulder, on meas. 24 he stamps.
- 5th figure 25-26 She turns CW away from the hold, then assume two hand hold, and arms swing forward and backward
- 27-32 as meas. 19-24, 4th figure
  There are a few ending measures which are at the same
  time introduction to the beginning: W turns CW, both
  face in LOD and assume position for the beginning of
  the dance.
