Little Brown Gal - Hula

(Hawaii)

Commentary: This hula is one of the most famous and popular of all Hawaiian folk dances. One of the reasons it is so popular is because its hand movements are easy to learn and understand. "Little Brown Gal" combines slower traditional movements with modern lyrics.

Formation: Any number of dancers on stage facing audience.

Basic Step: Vam - with knees flexed, gently swaying hips, opposite foot carrying weight. Step R to side, close L, step R to side, touch L foot at side of R, step L to side, close R, step R to side, touch R foot at side of L. Repeat throughout dance unless instructed otherwise.
