<u>Formation</u>	Mixed lines. Belt hold. L over R or hands joined down at sides. Face ctr, wt on L.
Style:	Slight knee flexion. Village style.
Measure	Pattern
	No introduction. Start at beginning of any phrase
	I. "SAW-TOOTH"
1 2	Step diag fwd R on R (1) step diag fwd R on L (2) moving away from ctr, step R diag bkwd R (1) continuing in same direction, step L bkwd (&) step R bkwd lifting L ft up in back (&)
3-4	Repeat action of meas. 1-2, reversing ftwrk and direction, retracing "saw-tooth" pattern. Repeat action as many times as desired by leader.
	2. SIDEWARDS WITH STAMPS
1	Facing ctr, step R to R (1) bring L up to R sharply and bend
2	knees (&) Repeat action again for counts "2 &" Facing slightly R, step on R in place, upper body bends fwd slightly(1) stamp L next to R (&) same in reverse for cts "2
3	Step on R diag fwd R (1) step on L in same direction
4	bringing R ft up behind (2) Moving away from ctr in a diag, step R to R, (1) close L to R
5-8	(&) step R to R (2) Same as in meas 1-4 Fig. 2 with reverse direction & ftwork Repeat action as many times desired by leader.
