Formation: Partners face, both hand joined across. Men have

back to center of circle.

Fig. I One two=step (or step-close step) in LOD We.left. she right

One tow-step in RLOD

With 4 walking steps, partners turn away from each

other, he CCW, she CW

Fig. II Face each other and clap your own thighs, own hands

and three times agains partners hands.

note; To make this dance a mixer do the following-One two-step in LOD, one two-step in RLOD; MEN WALK STRAIGHT AHEAD WHILE LADIES TURN TO THEIR RIGHT WITH FOUR STEPS..

Face your new partner and clap with him.

There are many dances called "Munchner Polka" with nothing in common than the name; neither are they from Munich as the name implies.
