## Königsberg-East Prussia

Suggested music: Tänze aus Ostpreussen Ka 75102 Tanz

Steps: Hop-steps, walking and Polka steps

Meter: 2/4

Formation: Couples around circle. Men have back to center.

Women face men. Both hands joined.

Fig. I: 1-4 Stepping on outside feet, men's left and

women's right, hop and swing free foot across

the other. Repeat in reverse.

In ballroom position, dance two turning Polka

steps in LOD.

Repeat this figure three more times.

Fig. II 5-16 Couple stands side by side, inside hands

joined. Beginning on outside feet, walk 2

steps forward, make  $\frac{1}{2}$  turn toward each other and walk 2 steps backwards. Repeat that pattern in RLOD

In ballroom position, dance 4 turning Polka

steps.

Repeat this figure.

Fig. III 17-20 Partners face and give both hands.

Stepping on outside feet, hop and swing inside feet across outside feet, and reverse. Without releasing handhold, walk into each other's places in a CW direction with 4 steps. Repeat this with same footwork back to place.

Dance 8 turning Polka steps moving CCW

around the ring.
