Step 1 Step R (ct 1); touch L slightly in front of R (2,3) 1 Repeat meas 1, opposite ftwk 2 Step on R (1); touch L in front of R (2); step on L (3)3 Step R turning to face cntr (1); touch L slightly in front of R (2,3) Step L (1); touch R slightly in front of L (2,3)4 Step back R (1); step slightly back L (2,3) Repeat meas 3-5 7-9 Step back R (1); touch L slightly in front of R (2,3) 10 11 Step L (1); step R (2,3) Pivot & turn and step back L (1); step R in place (2); step fwd 12 L (3) NOTE: Hands come up when the dancer steps in. Step II Same as Step I, but all touches are accompanied by two light 1-12 bounces on supporting ft on cts 2,3. Hands are up throughout. Step III Step R (1); step L (2); step R (3) 1 Repeat meas 1, opposite ftwk 2 34 Repeat meas 3, Step 1. Step R in place (1); step L in place (2); step R in place (3) 56 Step L (1); step R in place (2); step L in place (3) Step back R (1); touch L slightly in back of R and bounce twice (2,3) Repeat meas 3-5 7-9 Step back R (1); step L in place (2); step R in place (3) 10 Same as meas 11-12, Step 1. 11-12 NOTE: One turn can be executed on meas 3,7 and 11.
