Cpls in a closed circle. W on M's R. Hands joined at shldr height in W pos.

	1. Forward and back & woman around man
1	Step fwd on R towards ctr (1) pause (2) step fwd on L (3)
2	"Sink" onto R in place (1) touch ball of L briskly next to R (2) step on R in place (3)
3-4	Repeat pattern of meas 1-2 with opp direction and ftwrk
5-8	Repeat pattern of meas 1-4
9-12	Using small running steps (R-L-R) W runs full turn CW around M (from behind),
	inside hands are up (free hand on hip). M do small 1-2-3's in place
13-16	Facing partner with shldr-waist pos "swing" partner around CW, one full turn using small running steps L-R-L
17-32	Repeat pattern of meas 1-16, ending with partner to side, all cpls facing R of ctr (to begin next figure)

1	With partner to side and facing R of ctr, do a set of 1-2-3's (R-L-R) swinging inside hands fwd and outside hands back
2	Do another set of travelling 1-2-3's (L-R-L) swinging inside hands back and outside hands in
3-4	Repeat pattern of meas 1-2
5-8	Repeat pattern of meas 9-12, Fig. 1
9-16	Repeat pattern of meas 1-8 ending up in circle pos to begin Fig. 3
	3. Forward and back, woman around man with hand claps
1-4	Repeat pattern of meas 1-4, Fig. 1
5-8	W runs around M in CCW direction, passing in front of M and using 1-2-3's. W hands are resting on hips. M stay in place doing 3's and clapping hands ti rhythm
	(qqS) and keeping eye contact with partner
9-16	Repeat pattern of meas 9-16, Fig. 1
17-32	Repeat pattern of meas 1-16 ending in a circle to repeat dance

Dance repeats one more time as above, end last measure facing center with step-stamp
