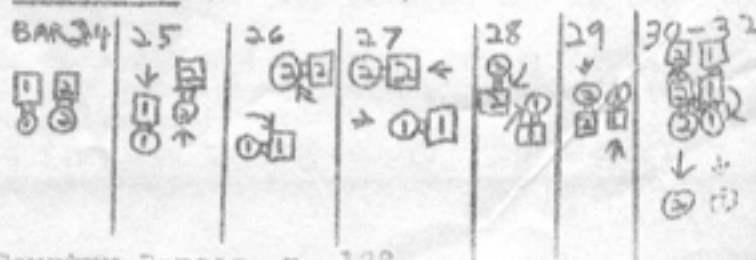
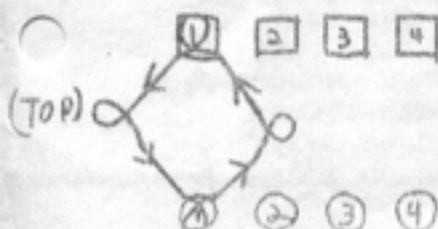
Time 2/4

This is a longways reel-time dance for two couples. A new top couple begins every second repetition.

- 1-16 The first couple dances in diamond formation with sixteen pas de basques. They each advance diagonally to the right, turning right round to face partner and set for two bars. This is repeated four times until they return to their original places.
- 17-24 The first man leads his partner down the middle and up again ending ready for a pousette. Second couple dances in on bar 24.
- 25-32 First and second couples change places with a pousette. (count: away from the center-quarter turn-up or down-quarter turn-into the center-half way round-fall back-fall back).

Repeat the dance with the next couple.*
