Source: This is a little dance done by the Negroes in the West Virginia hills. It depicts the action of a ping pong ball in a game.

Music: Any accented schottische. "Langa Sven," Victor V20008; "SkogensBlomster," Victor V20077B; "Rosemary," Imperial 1092. Formation: Couple dance, facing CCW in circle. Hands in skating position.

Weight on L ft, heel and toe with R ft. Step-close-step to R with R ft. With wt on R ft, heel and toe with L ft. Step-close-step to L with L ft. With wt on L ft step back with R, side with L, fwd with R, side with L, back with R, side with L, bring R to L with stamp and hold l ct. Wt on R ft: Step back with L, side with R, fwd with L, side with R, back with L, side with R, bring L to R with stamp and hold l count.
