FORMATION: In single circle (no ptrs), joined hands held down.

STEPS: Walk, stamp, step-hop

MUSIC: 2/4

Measures	<u>Pattern</u>
1-4	I. Moving CCW  Moving diag. fwd, walk R, L Face ctr, take 3 steps in place R, L, R. Turn to L and move bwd in LOD, walk L, R face
1-4	ctr, step in place a L, R, L. Repeat all. The steps in place are very light.
1-4 1-4	II. Moving to Ctr. and Back Walk to ctr 2 steps R, L. Stamp R, L, R. Walk bwd from ctr, 2 steps and clap 3 times. Repeat part II.
± +	More Difficult and Exciting Pattern
	Open circle with a <u>Leader</u> at right opening. Leader directs serpentine, winding and unwinding, etc. Take step pattern as above substituting low <u>step-hop</u> for <u>walking</u> step.
