

PLESKAVAC

Pleskavac (PLEHS-kah-vahtz — Clapping), a Serbian Clap Kolo.

Record: Balkan #518 "Pleskavac".

Formation: Open circle, leader at right.

Starting Position: Hands joined with arms extended straight downward, leader's free arm, with hand clenched, is held behind his back. Right foot free.

PART I

Measures

1 - 8 FOUR BASIC KOLO STEPS (Right, Left, Right, Left).

PART II

9 - 12 FOUR SIDE-CLOSE "REST STEPS", starting with Right foot.

PART III

13 - 16 THREE STAMPS AND THREE CLAPS. Stamp Right, Left, Right, Pause; Clap own hands three times, Pause.

Note: Part I was originally done with Four Walking Steps to the right and Four Walking Steps to the left. This simplified version may be presented first.
