POLKA ESPANOLA

(Visayan) Philippines

The Polka was very popular during the Spanish regime in the Philippines. Many variations are found throughout the Islands. This lively version from Negros Occidental, follows the polka rhythm although it does not use the traditional polka step.

COSTUME Girl wears Maria Clara style and Boy wears barong tagalog with black or any colored trousers.

MUSIC is divided into four parts: A, B, C, and D.

COUNT: One, and, two, and; one, ah, two, ah or one, two to a measure.

FORMATION: Partners stand side by side facing front, Girl at right side of Boy. One to any number of pairs may take part in this dance.
