

DULUTH MINNESOTA AUGUST 1977

POLKA OD PRZEWORSKA (Pshe-vor-ska) (Also known as Five And)
(Polka from village of Przeworsk)

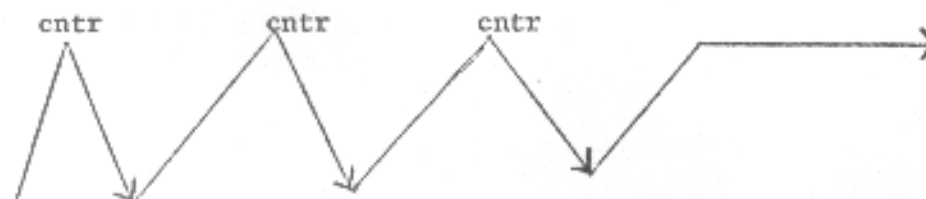
This dance is also called "Polka Wsciekła" (Furious Polka). The dance comes from the Rzeszów region and was learned from Leokadia Magdziarz of Rzeszów.

Music: Village Dances of Poland, Vol. II LTN 2. or Vol. III, LTN 3

Formation: Cpls face ctr, M R arm around Ptnr waist, W L hand on M R shoulder. Free arm hangs loose.

Meas PART I

- 1 Relaxed walk 1, 2, 3, swing free leg twd cntr diagonally fwd in LOD. M L, W R shoulder leads, look over shoulder
- 2 Back diagonally out, face ptnr, look over inside shoulder twd ptr.



- 3-6 Repeat meas 1-2 twice more
- 7 Repeat meas 1
- 8 Stamp, Stamp. M grabs W R wrist, his R hand in small of ptnr's back, L hand jammed into his L hip. W place L hd on M's R shoulder.

Count PART II

- Sit in plie. Start M face LOD, W RLOD. M R ft, W L ft.
- 1 Step in LOD
 - 2-3-4-5 Do four $\frac{1}{2}$ turns CW in plie, finish M LOD, W RLOD - TRAVEL! (Reach fwd on 1st ct).
 - 5& Cut M's L, W's R foot under standing ft and move in LOD.

Part II step repeats 2 more times. Finish with jump onto both feet.

Dance repeats 4 more times, Last time part I is twice as long and gets faster and faster.
