### Polska från Amot (Sweden)

Polska från Åmot (POHL-skah frohn OH-moht) is a polska variant from Åmot, Gästrickland. It was notated in 1976 by Benno Eriksson, Britt-Marie Rylander, and Tony Wrethling. Tommy and Ewa Englund presented it at the 1986 Scandia Festival (Berkeley) and at the 1991 University of the Pacific Folk Dance Camp.

CASSETTE: Englund Cassette - Stockton 1991 Side B/1;

3/4 meter

Bygdedansmusik RC 206 Side B/5.

FORMATION: Cpls in modified open ballroom pos facing in LOD (CCW). M R hand on W back above the waist and W L hand holding M upper R arm from the back, just below shldr. M L and W R hands joined palm to palm with fingers folded over ptr hand.

STEPS and STYLING:

Försteg (FUR-stayg): Description for M; W use opp ftwk. Step fwd on L ft, heel contacting the floor first followed by the full ft (cts 1-2): step fwd on R (ct 3). Step repeats exactly.

Polska: One meas completes one full turn CW while moving in LOD.

M: Beg a CW turn, step on L in front of W (ct 1); pivot CW on ball of L ft (ct 2); step on R twd LOD between ptr ft, placing heel down first and then taking full wt (ct 3). Step repeats exactly.

W: Beg a CW turn, step on R twd LOD between ptr ft, placing heel down first (ct 1); continue to pivot on ball of R ft (ct 2); step on L around ptr, pivoting to complete the CW turn (ct 3). Step repeats exactly.

Polska Hold: M R and W L hands are as in Försteg. M L hand hold W upper R arm; W R hand hold M upper L arm. Ptrs are standing very close.

Steps are smooth, even, and steady; the motion of the dancers is steady.

2 meas INTRODUCTION No action. (Other recordings may not have any Introduction.)

## I. FORSTEG

Any Number

Beg M L, W R dance fwd in LOD as many meas of Försteg as desired.

### II. WOMAN TURNS

M initiates the start of this figure by raising joined hands high and releasing hold of R hand. W release L hand. Hold free hands (M R, W L) down at sides. M may mark the start of this figure by stamping L ft (with wt) on ct l of the first meas.

#### Any Number

M: Continue fwd with Försteg.

 $\overline{W}$ : On each meas make one CW turn: Step fwd on R (ct 1); pivot CW on R (ct 2); step on L completing the CW pivot (ct 3).

M may turn CCW for one or two meas just before Fig III (Polska). Keeping hands joined, M turn CCW using opp ftwk from W.

### III. POLSKA TURN

M initiates the Polska Turn by lowering joined hands and taking polska poswith ptr.

Any Number In polska pos dance as many Polska steps as desired, turning CW and progress-ing in LOD.

DANCE SEQUENCE: Each figure is dance as long as desired. The three figures are always danced in the sequence given.

The Englunds usually danced the figures this long: Fig I - 2 to 4 meas; Fig II - 3 to 5 meas; Fig III - 8 to 16 meas.
