PRIDE OF DINGLE (Novelty dance)

Learned by Bruce Merritt at Ma shall Barron Workshop in Pittsburgh

MUSIC: "Vinton's Hornpipe" on "Southerners Plus Two Play Ralph Page"  
or other suitable music

formation: Longways sets for nine (9) dancers - four couples facing up  
plus one dancer alone at the top of the set facing down.

Part 1: Couples up a double and back while single person down a double and  
back ("double" is 4 counts).  
REPEAT

Part 2: Couples Right hand over (4 steps) and Left hand back (4 steps)  
REPEAT  
As the couples are doing this, the single person Right and Left hand  
down the center to the bottom of the set, actually making a Right  
hand 3-hand star with couple # 1, as they are crossing over, a Left  
hand 3-hand star with # 2 couple as they are crossing back, a Right  
3-hand star with # 3 couple and a Left 3-hand star with # 4 couple.

Part 3: The single person joins the line of the same sex at the bottom of the  
line and all dance a forward and back and again a forward and back,  
the line with the five people moving slightly toward the top of the  
set so everyone has a new partner opposite except for the NEW SINGLE  
person who is at the top of the set.

Part 4: Those with someone opposite swing (16 counts)
