Formation:

This is a couple dance. Couples facing in line

of direction and in Varsovian position.

Step 1:

(Everyone begins with Left foot)

Move forward and to the Right with a step-together-

step (L, R, L)

Step 2:

Begin with Right leg and move forward and to the Left

with a step-together-step (R, L, R)

Step 3:

Repeat step 1

Step 4:

Repeat step 2

Step 5:

Move straight ahead beginning with Left foot

(step-together-step) (L, R, L)

Step 6:

Lift Right knee and move backwards with a step-together-

step (R, L, R)

and Left knee is lifted in preparation for Step # 1

Begin again

VARIATION:

The second time you are repeating the dance, when you get to step 6, after lifting the Right knee, the girl turns to the Right for a 3 step complete turn (R, L, R)

and lifts the Left knee to begin step 1.
