Waltz, Polka

Formation:

Coules around the ring in ballroom position, men with back to center of circle.

Fig. I

One waltz turn with two steps. Point joined hands

in LOD and move forward with two waltzt steps, beginning

on outside feet.

Repeat three more times

Fig. II

One turn with two Polka steps.

dance straight forward with two Polka steps.

repeat three more times.

The Redowa was a fashionable ballroom dance at the end of the 19th and beginning of the 20th century. It is said to have had its origin in Checkoslovakia. "Rediwa" is a survival of this dance type.
