Styling*.

Border Country Dance Band, Fellside FE 007, Side A/2. 4/4 meter RECORD: The melody is a hornpipe.

FORMATION: Cpls in a circle, ptrs facing, M on the inside.

Strathspey*. Because of the fast tempo of the hornpipe, this basic step is modified so STEPS and that it resembles an ordinary schottish step*. STYLING: *Described in Steps and Styling, published by the Folk Dance Federation of California, Inc., 1275 "A"

Measures

9 - 12

13-16

TURN PARTNER, HONOR LEFT AND RIGHT

Join both hands with ptr and beg R turn once CW, arms held at chest level and rounded. 1-4

Advance and retire with the person diag to L. (Move fwd 2 strathspey steps and bkwd 2 5-8 strathspey steps.)

Dance back-to-back with ptr. moving CW and passing by the R shldr going fwd and L moving

Repeat meas 5-8, except advance and retire with person to R.

TURNS AND PROGRESS II.

1-4 Join R hands with ptr and, beg R, turn once CW.

Join L hands with the person diag to L and turn once CW. 5-8

9 - 12Repeat meas 1-4 (turning ptr by R).

Progress fwd, M LOD on the inside of the circle, W RLOD on the outside. Pass 4 people 13-16 counting ptr as #1.

Repeat dance with new ptr (the 5th person).
