2/4

Formation:

Square for 4 couples, Woman to right of Man. Hold inside hand at shoulder

level. Man's free hand(s) at vest, Woman's free hand(s) at skirt.

Style:

Throughout the dance maintain a springy kind of trot between walking and

running.

Pattern

Introduction:

4 measures or 8 counts.

FIGURE 1 - Circle

1-8 In a circle with hands in W-position, all walk 16 steps Clockwise in Reverse

Line of Direction starting right.

9-16 16 steps Counterclockwise in Line of Direction.

17-18 All bow to contra partner.

19-20 All bow to partner.

FIGURE 2 - Greetings

1-2 In square formation, head couples (1 & 3) meet in center in 4 steps.

3-4 Bow to other couple.

5-6 Couples back up to their place in 4 steps.

7-8 Head couples turn full Counterclockwise turn in place as a couple. Man goes

backward, Woman forward.

9-16 Side couples (2 & 4) do the same.

17-18 All bow to contra partner.

19-20 All bow to partner.

Sher Figure

1-2 Head Men to center in 4 steps.

3-6 Always facing each other, Men circle Clockwise in 8 steps.

7-8 In 4 steps Men back away to their place.

9-16 Head Women do the same. 17-24 Side Men do the same. 25-32 Side Women do the same.

FIGURE 1 - Circle

1-16 Repeat Measures 1-16 of Figure 1.

FIGURE 3 - Right & Left Hand Stars

1-8 All Men form Right-hand star for 16 steps.

9-16 Left-hand star for 16 steps.
17-18 All bow to contra partner.

19-20 All bow to partner.

21-40. Women do the same.

Meas 1-32	Sher Figure Repeat Sher figure.
1-16	FIGURE 4 - Grand Right & Left Forming a circle and facing partner, all dance a Grand Right and Left, Men with hands on vest, Women with hands holding skirts.
1-4	FIGURE 5 - Arches In 8 steps, couples 1 & 3 (head couples) cross over, couple 3 goes under the arch of couple 1.
5-8	Head couples turn half Counterclockwise turn in place as a couple. Man goes backward, Woman forward.
9-16 17-18 19-20 21-40	Head couples return home. Couple 1 goes under arch of couple 3. All bow to contra partner. All bow to partner. Side couples do the same, couple 2 forms arch first.
1-32	Sher Figure Repeat Sher figure.
1-16	FIGURE 1 - Circle Repeat Measures 1-16 of Figure 1. On last 4 counts all bow to center.
