## Sitno Shopsko Horo

Bulgarian Men's Dance

Notes The "Shops" are peasants around the city of Sofia in Western Bulgaria. This Shopsko Horo has a ten measure construction with a series of steps to the right, then to the left. Steps and variations differ from village to village.

Music Monitor Bulgarian LP or Sofiisko Shopsko -- XOPO X-309.

Formation Open circle with leader at right. Hands on neighbor's belt, right over left. The following steps are used in the dance:

"Graovka Step" (facing obliquely left, back to LOD)
Ct. 1 Tap (or hop) with L heel (foot), R foot slightly raises
from floor.

& Step back on R foot.

2 Step back on L foot with a deep flex. Repeat with start on L foot if done twice,

"Shopska Step" (facing LOD)

Ct. 1 Small step forward on R foot.

& Small step forward on L foot.

2 Small step forward on R foot, with deeper flex of the R knee.

& Pause with weight on R foot. L foot remains raised off of the floor

Repeat with start on L foot if done twice.

1- 2	Two Graovka steps going CCW backward.
3- 4	Two Shopska steps going CCW forward.
5	Ct. 1 Facing center, leap on R foot, bringing L knec high.
	2 Stamp. L heel beside R foot, bending both knees.
6	Ct. 1 Hop on R foot.
	& Step on L foot to left.
	2 Cross and step on R foot in front of L foot with weight on it.
	& Pause.
7	Ct. 1 Mop on R foot
,	& Step on L foot to left.
	2 Cross and step on R foot in front of L foot with weight on it.
	& Pause.
8	Ct. 1 Step on L foot to left.
Ü	2 Hop L, swing P foot in front of L foot.
9-10	Two Shopska steps forward toward center

NOTE: Starting with meas. 5 thru 10, dancers are facing center.
