	Chorus - Repeat a, b, c - all join hands in a circle on last 2 measo
FIG.	III - Thread the Needle - M of Cpl. 1 & W of Cpl. h release hands

Cpl 1 raise joined hands. W of Cpl 4 pass under arch leading the others behind her. She passes behind W of Cpl 1 & back to poss. Repeat - Cpl 4 making arch & M of Cpl 1 leading the others. 16 Finish with Circle sidestep as in beginning of dance.
