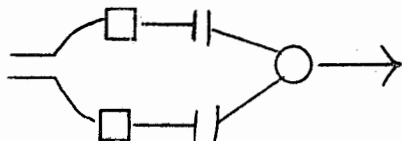


Spinnradl for Three

(Germany)

Note: Spinnradl, the couple dance is from Southern Germany and upper Austria. The version for three was taught in Oregon by Vyts Beliajus and is perhaps a pattern arranged in the U.S.A.

Formation: Threes face CCW in the large circle. The center person has hands joined with the outside hands of the other two who join their inside hands behind his back.



Measure

Pattern

| 1-8 | Starting R for all - waltz diagonally fwd R, L, R, L, R, L, R, L. |
| 9-11 | Without dropping hands center person back under joined raised hands of the other two persons, around the outside person, continue turning until back to the original places (9 cts). |
| 12-14 | Repeat the turning figure around the inside person (9 cts). |
| 15 | One waltz step fwd. |
| 16 | jump. |
| 17-24 | Repeat meas 9-16. |
