SRPSKO (SEHRP-skoh)

This is their version of the basic 2/4 symmetric 8-measure Serbian dance type which includes both the older Kukunješte (or or o) and the newer U šest (o) type dances. Hence the name Srpsko = "Serbian." I have presented here descriptions of Pestani versions of.
