STA TRIA

(Stis Treis)

Characteristics: Gay but heavy feeling.

Formation: Open circle, moving counter-clockwise with regular

W handhold.

Time: 2/4
Steps:

1, 2 Side r., then almost together l.

1, 2 Side r., point l. toe in front r. (Face counter-clockwise)

1, 2 Side l. to left and point r. toe in front of l. (Face clockwise)

Variation

1,2 Side r. almost together l.

1,2 Side r., slightly pivot on it to the left and touching l. toe on ground near r.; l. heel is off ground and knee flexed. (Face clockwise)

1,2 Slightly pivot on l. to the right, placing it entirely on the ground and touch r. toe on ground near it. R. heel is off ground and knee flexed. (Face counter-clockwise)

(The Fishing Net)

Characteristics: This is danced by women in Megara only at Eastertime, with air of restrained joy with proud bearing. Formation: Quarter-moon circle, moving counter-clockwise with basket-weave handhold.
