Measure

Facing LOD, Step R to right (1&), Close L to R (2), Step R to R (&)

2 Reverse foot work in LOD

Cross R in front of L (1&), Step L to left (2), Step R behind L (&)

4 Step L to left (1&), Cross R over L (2), Step back on R(&)

Variation: Measure Three:

Step R to right to face center (1 &), Step L in place, (2), Step R behind L (&).
