This recreational dance was choreographed in Germany by H. Hepp to the music recorded on Fidula-Fon 232. Subsequently Carmen Irminger of Benglen, Switzerland used a Swiss recording (ZYT LP 232 - De Vogeli) and the popularity of the dance increased. Carmen taught it at the 1997 University of the Pacific Folk Dance Camp at Stockton. California.

Separate from ptr by walking 4 small steps bkwd.

Quickly stamp (with wt) 3 times (cts 1,&,2); hold (ct &); clap 3 times (cts 3,&,4).

Hook R elbows with ptr and turn CW for 8 steps. At end, release ptr.

Quickly find a new ptr. Hook L elbows and turn CCW for 8 steps.

Joining inside hands with this new ptr, start the dance again.
