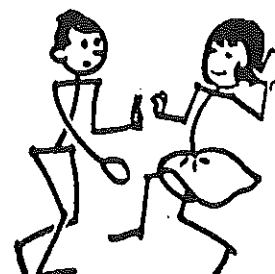


TEXAS FREEZE

Country Western Dance

Origin: U. S. A.
 Music: Wild Turkey
 Record: KTEL - WU 3680
 Formation: Line dance or couple dance (closed freeze)

- Part 1 - Step to Right
 Left foot behind Right
 Step Right and chug with Left foot
- Part 2 - Step to Left
 Right foot behind Left
 Step Left and chug with Right foot
- Part 3 - Step back with Right foot
 Another step back with Left foot
 Step back again on Right foot
 And do a rocking step with a Left, Right, Left
 Hop a quarter turn to the Left



And begin the Dance again.....

This dance is done to the four corners and....
 REPEATS

Couple Dance:

Steps remain the same, only they are performed less vigorously. The man holds the lady in varsovien position for steps 1, 2, and 3. When the hop step begins, the man's Right hand comes over the lady's head and drops down (still holding Right hand) The Left hand is placed behind him and the lady places her Left hand in his.

The second time the hop step is done, he brings the lady's Right hand over his Right shoulder.

The third time the hop step is done, the man brings the lady's Right hand over his head and drops her Left hand so that she is now in front of him.

The fourth time, the lady pulls the man's Right hand over her Right shoulder. Both Right and Left hands are clasped, the man is in front and the dance begins again.
