INTRODUCTION: Begin dance with vocal after a very short 6 note instrumental introduction.

  Facing ctr, step R to R (ct 1); hold (ct 2); step R behind
  L (ct 3).
- 2 Repeat meas 1.
- 3 Step R to R (ct 1); step R next to L (ct 2); step R in place (ct 3).
- 4 Repeat meas 3, with opp ftwk.
- Continuing to face ctr, step R fwd, flex R knee (ct 1); hold (ct 2); step L fwd (ct 3).
- 6 Stamp R fwd (ct 1); hold (ct 2); take wt off R (ct 3).
- 7 Step R directly bkwd (ct 1); step L next to R (ct 2); step R in place (ct 3).
- 8 Repeat meas 7, with opp ftwk.
- 9-16 Repeat meas 1-8, once more (2 in all).

  Turning to face and move in LOD, do 8 two-steps, beginning R.

  Lower joined hands to "V" pos.

Repeat dance from beginning.
