

# TUCSONOVOSKA KOPANICA

(Bulgaria [sic])

Notes by Andrew Carnie April 11, 2000.

This dance, from the village of Tucsonovo in southwestern deserted region of Bulgaria, is traditionally danced around cacti to cure scorpion bites and indigestion.

RHYTHM: 11/8 QQSQQ

MUSIC: Balkan Journeys close to home GHP004-2: track 11. Lupcevo

FORMATION: Open circle, hand held down

DANCE:

Bar 1: facing LOD step slowly on R (QQ) Step slowly on L (S) Step R (Q) Step L (Q)

Bar 2: turning to face center step R to R (Q) hop on R (Q) Bring left leg up and around behind right calf, step on L (S) Step R (Q) Step L (Q)

Repeat until the end of the music.
