Vlasinka (Kaludjerce, Leskovac - Serbia)

I learned this dance in 1983 from the villagers of Kaludjerce, Serbia. I also learned another similar version from Desa Djordjević at the 1987 Ljetna Skola Folklora in Lipik, Croatia.

Pronunciation:

VLAH -seen-kah

Cassette:

Serbian Village Dances KF '82'

Meter:

2/4

Styling:

All kicks are low in front, and also may have a preparatory lift

in back.

Formation:

Line or open circle, alternating M & W. Leader at the R end.

Back basket hold, W arms under, M arms over. Dance is done

facing ctr.

Meas.

1	Step on R ft to R (ct 1); step on L ft across in front of R (ct 2).
2	Step on R ft to R (ct 1); step on L ft across in front of R (ct 2).
3	Step on R ft to R (ct 1); kick L ft low towards ctr (ct 2).
4	Step on L ft in place (ct 1); kick R ft low towards ctr (ct 2).
5	Step on R ft in place (ct 1); kick L ft low towards ctr (ct 2).

Repeat meas 1 - 5 with opp ftwk and direction.

Individual variations:

For meas 1 & 2

Hop on L ft (ct 1) step on ball of R ft to R (ct &): step on L ft across in front of R (ct 2).

This variation can be done at any time in place of meas 1 &/or 2, or both.
