FARENELL TO AUCHTERAFDER (Scotland)

Farewell to Auchterarder (AHK-tehr-ahr-der) is a fairly modern dance, only a few years old, whose figures were devised by Bill Hamilton of Scotland. This cance was introduced to California dancers in the summer of 1969 by C. Stewart Smith.

MUSIC:

Fecord: "Ian Powrie's Farewell to Scotland"

Waverly 25011, Side 2, Band 1; Waverly ZLP 2087

FORMATION:

4 cpls in a square (W to M R), cpl 1 with back to music, other cpls

numbered CW around the square.

STEPS:

All steps are in 6/8 meter: Sliding Step (Slip Step)*, Skip change of step*, Pas de basque*, Set*

Figure of Eight (8 meas): W 1 and W 3 dance between their inactive cpls and loop CW around inactive M, as h 1 and M 3 loop CCW around inactive W (4 meas). Then W 1 and W 3 dance between their inactive cpls and loop CCW around inactive W, while M 1 and M 3 dance CW around inactive M (4 meas). The active W always crosses in front of her ptr as she goes between the inactive cpl to begin her loop around, and the k always crosses behind her.

INTRODUCTION M bow, W curtsey to ptr.

PART I

I HANDS AROUND

1-8 All cpls join

All cpls join hands at shoulder height and circle L with 8 sliding steps, then R with 8 sliding steps. Release hands.

II W R-HAND WHEEL

9-12 All W pass in front of ptr and dance behind next M (original L-hand M), CW around him and into the middle of the dance.

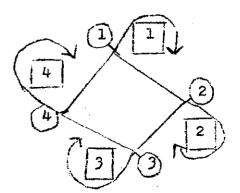
13-16 All W dance a R-hand wheel once around CW.

17-20 All W then pass in front of original opp M and dance behind next M (original R-hand M) to finish in the middle of the dance.

21-24 All W dance a R-hand wheel once around, finishing in promenade pos with ptr facing CW around the square, W on inside.

III PROMENADE

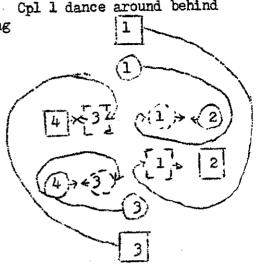
25-32 All cpls promenade once around to own places.



PART II I PROMENADE AROUND, SET, AND TURN

Cpls 1 and 3 continue promenade CW. Cpl 1 dance around behind cpl 2 and release hands, M 1 dancing around h 2 to finish facing him in the middle while W 1 dances around W 2 to finish facing her. Simultaneously, cpl 3 dance around behind cpl 4 and release hands, M 3 dancing around N 4 to finish facing him, while W 3 dances around W 4 to finish facing her.

5-8 All Set and turn person they are facing with R hands once around to finish as before in lines of 4.



REEL OF 4

All cpls dance a reel of 4 across the dance to finish in lines 9-16 of 4 as before.

III FIGURE OF 8

Cpl 1 dance a complete figure of 8 around cpl 2 while cpl 3 dance 17-24 a Figure of 8 around cpl 4. Cpls 1 and 3 finish in the ctr facing in, W on M R.

IV L-HAND WHEEL AND PROMENADE

Cpls 1 and 3 dance a L-hand wheel around 3/4 CCW. 25-28 Cpl 1 in promenade pos continue CCW around the square dancing 29-32 around, behind cpl 2 to return to original place. Simultaneously cpl 3/promenade pos dance around behind cpl 4 to return to original place.

Cpls 2 and 4 repeat action of meas 1-32 (PART II), dancing around 33-64 behind cpls 3 and 1. The reels of 4 will be up and down the dance, and cpls 3 and 1 will stand still during the Figure of 8. On last meas M 1 and 3 dance one Skip change of step L into ctr to assume promenade pos with ptr, all facing CCW around the square,

PART III I PROHENADE

All cpls promenade once around to own places. Release hands. 1-8

II M L-HAND WHEEL

All M pass in front of ptr and dance behind next W (original R-hand 9-12 W), around her and into the middle of the dance.

13-16 All M dance a L-hand wheel once around CCW.

All M then pass in front of original opp W and dance behind next 17-20 W (original L-hand W) to finish in the middle of the dance.

All M dance a L-hand wheel once around, finishing in own place 21-24 at W L.

III HANDS AROUND

25-32 All cpls join hands at shoulder height and circle R with 8 sliding

steps, then L with 8 sliding steps.

Chord M bow, W curtsey to ptr.

DANCE: MUSIC: RECORD:	Yoav Ashriel Chassidic Folk Melody Dancecraft LP 123301, Side B, Band 3
FORMATION:	Open circle, hands joined and held down.
FIGURE I 1- 2 3- 4 5-20	Face centre of circle. A forward and backward rocking motion is used throughout Figure I. Step bend on L ft. slightly crossing over R ft. Body is slightly bent fwd. Step bend on R ft. to R side, straightening body. Repeat counts 1-4, four more times.
FIGURE II 1-3 4 5 6 7 8 9-16	Move C.C.W. Three stamps fwd. beginning with L ft. Body is slightly bent fwd. Hold Stamp on R ft. to the R side, turning to face centre of circle. Straighten body. Cross L ft. behind R ft. Stamp on R ft. to R side. Hold Repeat counts 1-8.
FIGURE III 1- 4 5- 8 9-12 13-16	Box Step Two step bends beginning with L ft. Hove towards centre of circle. Knees are relaxed. Turn slightly to R. Gross L ft. over R ft. moving to R (Count 5) Step on R ft. to R side (Count 6) Gross L ft. over R ft. (Count 7) Hold. (Count 8) Two step bends beginning with R ft. moving bkwd out of circle. KHOROVOD (Ukrainian)

SOURCE:

Learned by Vincent Evanchuk from Cienka, in Kiev, Ukraine, 1963. This dance, a wedding dance, is one of the oldest dance forms in the Slavic countries. It probably predates Kiev-Russ which would place it at approximately 900 A.D. The dance is done at weddings only. Since this dance is done by the elders as well as the younger people of the gathering, it is done with great pomp, ceremony and tranquility.

MUSIC:

Record: Special recording, Festival Folkshop.

METER:

2/4 time, 7 meas per phrase, 3 phrases per verse.

FORMATION:

Cplsvin a large circle facing CCW, M on the inside. W L hand in M L hand and both held out to the front. W R hand is down at her side, M R arm cradling the W shoulders but not touching them.

STEPS:

DORIZKA (Counted 1, &, 2, &)

Meas 1, Ct 1 Step down on R ft (flat).

Ct & Lift wt off of R ft slightly, with the wt going to the ball of the L ft.

Ct 2 Repeat action of ct 1.

Ct & Repeat action of preceding ct &.

NOHOO KHELAI

Meas 1, Ct 1 Step on R ft (flat) with slightly bent knee.

Ct 2 Swing L ft fwd with slight lift about 8 inches

from floor. Straighten knees on lift.

Meas 2 Repeat action of meas 1 starting with L ft.

PRECID DO BEEK (Counted 1, &, 2, &) M only.

Meas 1, Ct 1,& M drops R arm and leaps to R side while executing a mid-air 1/4 turn CCW and land on both ft in a squatting pos.

Ct 2,& Hop to a half-up pos on the R ft, L ft is extended L side.

Meas 2, Ct 1 Start a 3/4 CCW turn by stepping to the L onto the L ft.

Ct & Complete 1/4 of the CCW turn by swinging the R ft in a small arc and momentarily taking wt on the ball of the R ft.

Ct 2.& Continue the turn by stepping L on L ft and swinging the R ft around to help make the turn. Turn ends with M facing in original pos of meas 1.

PRECID DO BEEK Repeat all of the preceding except for meas 2, ct 2, &, which is replaced by a hold, standing on the L ft with the R ft brought to the ankle of the L.

MUSIC 2/4

PATTERN

Meas.

FIG. I

- 1-4 Beginning M R, W R dance 8 DORIZKA steps in LOD.
- 5-7 With 6 DORIZKA steps each cpl executes its own individual 1/4 turn CCW. Cpl ends facing ctr of circle.

FIG. II

8-14 W move to ctr of circle beginning with R ft with 7 NOHOO KHELAI steps. Arms are down at sides. In stand in place with arms at sides.

FIG. III

15-21 M moves to ctr of circle beginning with R ft with 7 NOHOO KHELAI steps, arms at sides. M reaches W L side on 7th meas. W stands in place with arms at sides.

FIG IV

- 22-23 Cpls assume original pos and beginning M R and W R, execute 1/2 turn CCW with 4 DORIZKA steps. Finish facing out of circle.
- 24-26 Nove out of circle with 6 DORIZKA steps.
- 27-28 Execute 1/2 turn CCW with 4 DORIZKA steps. Finish facing ctr of circle.

FIG. V

- 29-30 Beginning R, M executes a PRECID DO BEEK directly in front of ptr thru the arch formed by M L and W R arms. During the squat M R shoulder and arm are pointed to the ctr of circle.
- 31-32 M repeat action of meas 29-30. During meas 29-32 W dance 8 DORIZKA steps in place.
- 33-35 M hold with wt on L ft while W do a slow, full turn CCW under L arm (M L and W R hands are still joined, M R arm is extended to side as in FIG. I) with 6 DORIZKA steps.

FIG. VI

- 36-37 Drop joined arms to chest level. M does 4 DORIZKA steps in place. W does 4 DORIZKA steps making 1/2 turn CCW to face out of circle and into M R arm.
- 38-39 With 4 DORIZKA steps N and W make 3/4 turn CW while maintaining the same relative pos to each other. M finish facing RLOD and W LOD.

FIG VI (Continued)

- W do 2 DORIZKA steps in place and M swing R arm down to side, and, with 2 DORIZKA steps, makes 1/2 turn CW and swings R arm up to pos of FIG. I.
- 41-42 With 4 DORIZKA steps, W moves across to M R side without turning and moving under their own L arm. Final pos is the same as that of FIG. I.
- 43-77 Repeat FIGS. I thru V. First meas is used to make 1/4 turn CW to face LOD.

FIG. VII

A slow measured walk off the floor to the sides. There is no floor pattern in the direction of movement. The walk is on the beat, 2 steps per meas. The W places her head on M R shoulder and M R arm cradles W R shoulder.
